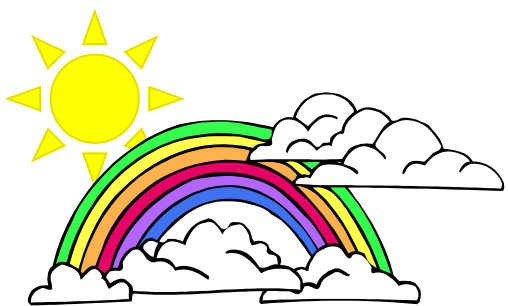

Our five-day work mission and weekend teams share their witness as they become the hands and feet of Jesus Christ by giving their time and talents to homeowners in need.

Work mission teams are made up of children of God of all ages and skill levels.

The following are some of the programs that the Epworth Center is in the process of **considering / implementing**:

- Parish Nurse Program: assessing local health needs of persons who cannot afford health care
- Tutoring Program: tutoring opportunities to both grade and high school students who will most likely take a positive step away from poverty.
- Hunger Program: helping the "working poor" provide food for their families.
- Counseling: providing a safe place where persons can talk about their issues; it is the hope that growth and positive choices will be the outcome.
- New Cabin Project: the Epworth Center is in the planning stages of building a new cabin which will sleep 40 and have a common area for guests.
